Guide to Uniform – School Footwear

- We expect all students to wear our uniform, which reflects our high expectations. It is the first thing to be seen by the public, so we expect students to wear uniform properly at all times, including walking to and from school.
- The school policy for footwear is black shoes or ALL BLACK trainers. This
 means no colour of any size. There must be black stitching, black laces,
 black logos, black sole and black tags.

- If students do not adhere to the policy, they will be given a pair of shoes to wear or parents will be contacted so that they can go home to change.
