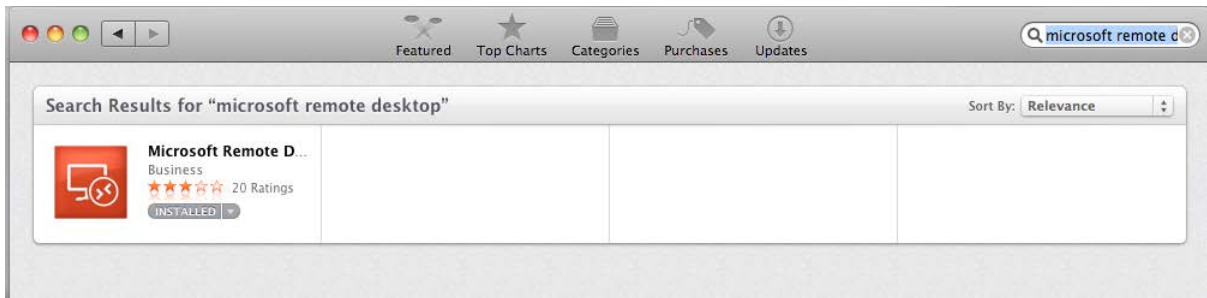


Accessing Microsoft Remote Desktop from an Apple Mac

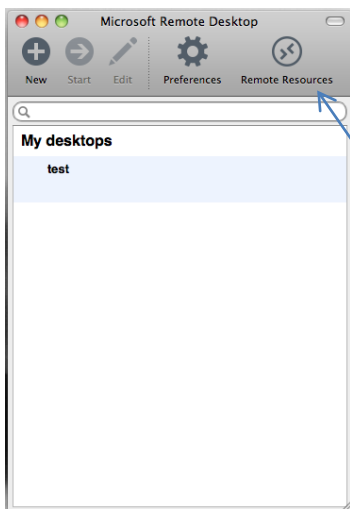
Step 1

To access Microsoft Remote desktop from a Mac firstly you need to download the remote desktop app from the app store, on your mac computer click on the app store icon and search from Microsoft Remote desktop App which should look like image below. Once you have found this you need to select the app to download and install to your Mac.

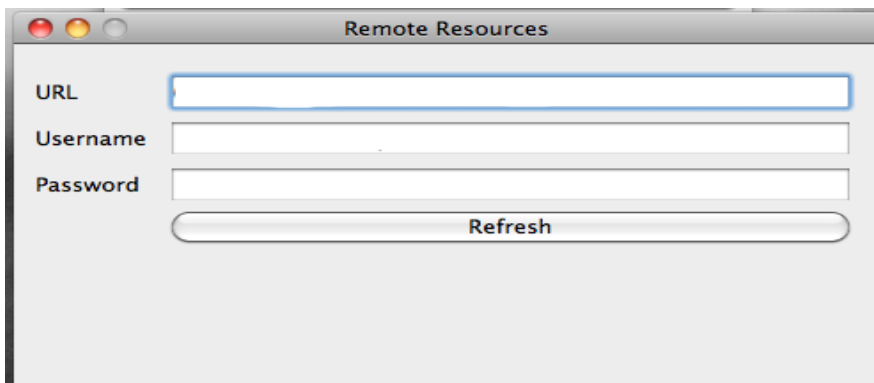


Step 2

Once you have downloaded the Microsoft Remote Desktop app you will see this appear along your icon list bar. Click the icon to load the software where you should be seeing a screen like this



Once this screen has loaded, click on the remote resource button to load the following option



Step 3

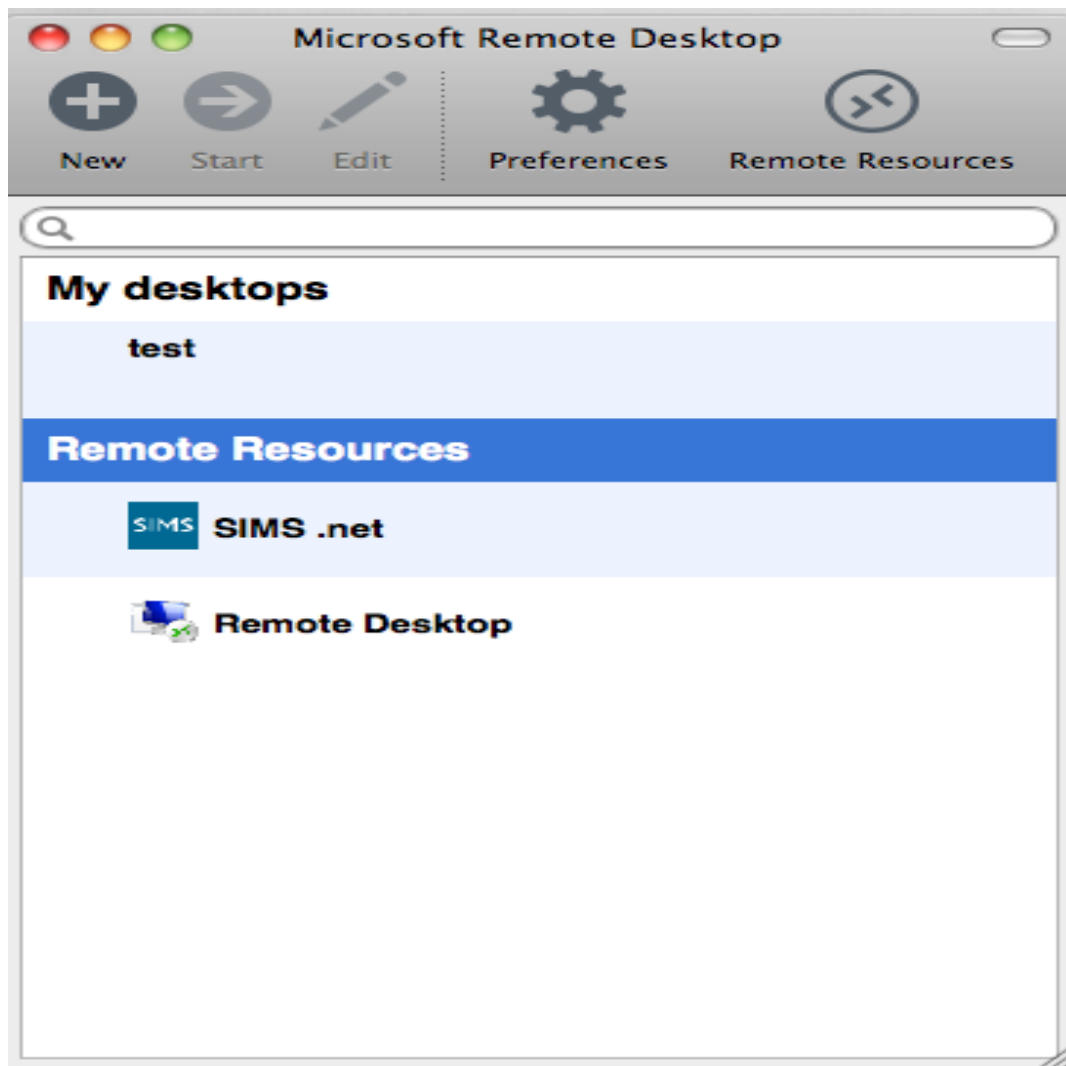
You now need to complete the following boxes with your user credential eg.

URL: <https://remote.blaconhighschool.net>

Username: blaconhs\Your Username

Password: Your school login password

Once you have completed the fields click refresh and then close the box this should then display a page like so



Step 4

Once box above is displayed you have successfully completed the connection stage all you need to do now is click remote desktop and then start. This will then load you a full windows desktop and give you access to selected school features like office and SIMS.net and your shared drives remotely.
