Any questions your child may have will be answered during this day. All students can choose to receive a free school meal on the first day back, to sample a range of food from our Diner.

8.45am-9.15am – Please arrive via the student entrance on Auckland Road where I will be there to greet your child along with your child's Form Tutor. Students will make their way to the Sports Hall where there will be a welcome assembly.
