As we come to the end of the spring term, I would like to thank students and parents/carers for your hard work and support. Due to Good Friday on 29<sup>th</sup> March, school will close for the Easter/spring break on Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> March with students being dismissed at the usual time of **3.10pm**. We return to school for the summer term on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> April 2024.

Following our Ofsted inspection in November 2023 and a follow-up visit in February 2024, I have now received the Ofsted report which is available on the school website to view. I remain proud of all that has been achieved and we continue to work together to achieve great things as we move forwards. There have been many amazing events that have taken place this half term as a result of the hard work, dedication and resilience of our staff and students. This week we have celebrated with students and parents/carers in our rewards assemblies to recognise the fantastic dedication and hard work of our outstanding students, with some of those students also going out on reward trips.

We have had a variety of sporting activities and events each week and we continue to develop and offer enriching opportunities and experiences for all, both at lunchtime and after school. We currently have a total of 56 clubs on offer and so far 54% of all students have been involved in these. 99% of Year 11 have attended a club and we are delighted that so many students have been accessing period 6 in support of preparation for their examinations this summer.
