Year 8 Enrichment Trip, Tuesday 16th July 2024

Dear Parents and Carers,

On Tuesday 16th July 2024, Year 8 students have the opportunity to take part in an enrichment trip to Broughton Park; this will involve a movie screening of *Despicable Me 4*, and lunch either at McDonald's or Tim Hortons. Students can bring their own packed lunch if preferred. This day is a celebration of their hard work and achievements during academic year 2023-2024.

The cost of the trip (transport and movie) is **£16.00, which is non-refundable and must be paid in full by Friday 12th July**. We have tried to keep costs to a minimum; however, this price reflects the increases in coach hire costs. Please also ensure your child brings enough money with them to purchase lunch from their preferred restaurant on the day. To support us in arranging groups of students, please indicate which venue your child would prefer to eat at, when completing your online consent form.

To confirm your child's place, please give consent and pay the deposit of £9.50 through your online ParentPay account by the extended deadline of Friday 21st June 2024. If you do not have a ParentPay account, please collect a barcoded letter and a Form C from the office. The barcoded letter can be used to make payment at your local PayPoint store; the closest location to school is the Spar shop on Western Avenue. Cash cannot be accepted by school.



We expect to return to Blacon High School by 3.10pm where students will be dismissed to make their own way home. It is the responsibility of all parents/carers to ensure that their child gets home safely upon arrival back at school.

Please ensure that your child brings plenty to drink for all visits outside school; when the weather is warm, it is even more important to stay hydrated. If you would like to provide snacks for the movie screening, please send no more than one small bag of sweets.
