Dear Parents and Carers,

Greenway Walk – Thursday, July 18th, 2024

On Thursday, July 18th, staff and students, as part of activities week, will participate in a 12km walk along the Greenway. This annual event is a wonderful opportunity to strengthen our school community and enjoy a healthy outdoor activity together.

Staff members will accompany students and will also be stationed at strategic checkpoints to ensure safety. Students will walk with their tutor and year groups, departing at staggered times starting with Year 7 leaving first, followed by Years 8, 9 and 10.

Portable toilets and drinking water will be available at the halfway point.
Please remind your child to stay on the designated route and remain in sight of their teachers.

Students are not required to wear school uniforms. They should wear suitable clothing and footwear for walking and apply sun cream before coming to school as the forecast is currently expected to be sunny. The walk will proceed unless there is a forecast for persistent heavy rain. If showery weather is expected, students should bring a waterproof jacket.

Students should bring water and snacks for the walk. They must also bring any empty packets and wrappers back to school and dispose of them in the bins provided.

Upon returning to school, there will be a BBQ, ice cream, and games on the school field. We request a small contribution of £1.50 towards the cost of the BBQ and ice cream, which can be paid through Parent Pay.

This event aims to include the entire school community. For students who are physically unable to walk the entire distance, arrangements will be made to allow them to participate to the extent they are able. If this applies to your child, please contact us at admin@blaconhigh.cheshire.sch.uk
