History Department, London Trip - Monday 7<sup>th</sup> July – Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> July 2025

Dear Parent / Carer,

Further to my previous letter inviting your child to attend an educational History trip to London, I write to inform you that in order to make this trip more cost effective, the cost and itinerary has been revised.

The revised trip will take place on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> July 2025, as a two day tour with one night stay. This trip will compliment the Year 9 curriculum studying the Victorian era, World War One, World War Two, and the Holocaust.

The new total cost of the trip is **£350** per student, to include:

- Dinner at the accommodation
- Breakfast at the accommodation
- Trip to London Dungeons
- Entrance to the Imperial War Museum, London
- West End Show (specifics tbc)

Places are limited and available on a first come first served basis, with a payment plan:

- **Payment 1 (Deposit) £50** – 4<sup>th</sup> December 2024
- **Payment 2 £100** – 10<sup>th</sup> February 2025
- **Payment 3 £100** – 30<sup>th</sup> March 2025
- **Payment 4 £100** – 21<sup>st</sup> April 2025

\* If you have already paid the deposit, your place is secure and the second payment will be adjusted.

Please ensure the deposit is paid by **Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> December 2024**. If you do not have a ParentPay account, please collect a Form C and a barcoded letter from the office. The barcoded letter can be used to make payment at your local PayPoint store.

*Payments collected for visits are done so according to the tour operator or booking agencies regulations and are therefore non-refundable in most cases. The terms and conditions of the Tour Operator or Agent will apply. Please ensure that your child is committed to the trip before any payments are made.*
