Dear parent and carer,

Higher Level Maths Achievement Programme (HLMAP)

We are writing to inform you about an opportunity for your son or daughter to take part in the Higher Level Maths Achievement Programme (HLMAP), and to request your consent for them to attend a Student Study Day as part of this programme.

HLMAP is a national programme delivered by the Advanced Mathematics Support Programme and Maths Hubs. It is designed to support students with high prior attainment in maths, particularly those from disadvantaged backgrounds, to achieve strong outcomes at GCSE and to consider studying maths at Level 3. The programme is informed by research and has already shown strong success nationally in improving GCSE results and progression into further maths study.

As part of HLMAP, students attend Student Study Days which focus on mastering demanding GCSE topics, developing mathematical problem solving skills, and building confidence with higher tier exam style questions. These sessions are designed to stretch and challenge students while supporting them to reach their full potential. At least one of the study days will take place at a local university, giving students an insight into learning in a higher education environment.

Your child has been identified as suitable for this programme due to their strong prior attainment in maths and their potential to achieve highly at GCSE. All study day activities will be fully supervised by school staff and programme staff throughout the day. Students will need to bring a packed lunch on the day. If your child is eligible for Free School Meals, a lunch will be provided.
