Year 11 Prom, Friday 26th June 2026

Dear Parents and Carers,

It is with great pleasure that I am able to confirm the arrangements for the 2026 Year 11 Prom, taking place at **McDonald Craxton Wood on the 26th June 2026, 7pm – 10.30pm.** The total cost of entry for the evening is £40.00, which will include a welcome drink, a hot buffet and a DJ for the evening.

This will be a lovely event to celebrate this fantastic group of students who will have reached the end of their secondary education with us at Blacon. They are proving to be a mature, respectful and hardworking cohort, and I know so many staff members are looking forward to sharing the evening with them all.

To secure your child's place please give consent and make payment through your online ParentPay account or by a Form C and barcoded letter (available from the office). In order to support with the cost of this event, payments can be made in instalments as needed but consent and a deposit of £15 is required by Friday 30th January 2026. A further £15 payment will be required by Friday 20th March, with final payment required by Friday 24th April.

To help support with the cost of the event, we have launched an incentive where students can earn money off their ticket by attending scheduled revision sessions before or after school. They have the opportunity to earn 50% off their ticket. Students will be given a 'Passport to Prom' card, and if students attend forty period 6 sessions before they begin their exams in May then they will be eligible for a £20 refund on their prom ticket.

All Year 11 students are currently invited to the Prom; however, failure to adhere to the schools CORE Principles, or any significant issues that your child is involved in, could result in this invitation being rescinded.

It is vital that you and your child are aware that they will only be allowed to attend the Prom if they continue to behave well in school and that they are also expected to demonstrate this exceptional behaviour on the evening of the event.

The dress code is formal evening wear (e.g. suit, dress, tuxedo).

Please be aware that school will not be providing transport to or from the venue on the evening of the Prom; it is your responsibility to ensure your child's safety regarding transport. Please ensure arrangements are made for your child's transport to arrive at the venue by 10.30pm

I appreciate your support in recognising that alcohol will not be served or permitted.

We hope your child will be able to attend what should be a memorable and enjoyable occasion, to officially conclude their time at Blacon High School.
