Rewind Project – Cheshire Dance

I am delighted to inform you that your child has been selected to be coached by Cheshire Dance and to perform in their new Rewind Project.

Cheshire Dance will be delivering creative dance workshops led by Emma Thomas, a professional creative dance artist, to create an inspiring performance piece for the *Rewind Project*. Original music is being specially composed for our dancers by Matt Baker.

Rewind, delivered by Cheshire Dance in partnership with Theatre in the Quarter, is an exciting theatre and movement project for young people in the Blacon area. The project brings together music and dance, with children from six local schools collaborating to create a storyline and performance.

Cheshire Dance is a well-established dance charity, approaching its 50th year, which provides transformative dance experiences for people of all ages and believes that everybody can dance.
