Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 7 and 8, Gulliver's World, Tuesday 14th July 2026

On Tuesday 14th July 2026, Year 7 and 8 students will have the opportunity to take part in a trip to Gulliver's World theme park, to celebrate their hard work and achievements during academic year 2025-2026.

The total cost of the trip is **£25** which is **non-refundable** and must be paid in full **by Monday 22nd June 2026**. To confirm your child's place, please give consent and pay a deposit of £10.00 through your online ParentPay account by **Friday 5th June 2026** (login to ParentPay and click the yellow 'pay for other items' box). The remaining £15.00 is to be paid by Monday 22nd June 2026.

If you do not have a ParentPay account, please collect a barcoded letter and a Form C from the office. The barcoded letter can be used to make payment at your local PayPoint store; the closest location to school is the Spar shop on Western Avenue. Cash cannot be accepted by school.


We will travel by coach from school, departing at **9.15am** promptly, and leaving Gulliver's World at 2.50pm. We expect to return to Blacon High School by **3.45pm** where students will make their own way home. It is the responsibility of all parents and carers to ensure that their child gets home safely upon arrival back at school.

Students can wear their own clothes, which should be suitable for the weather and appropriate, and should be reminded that they are still representing the school. Any student who arrives into school wearing clothing deemed inappropriate may not be able to attend the trip.

You will need to provide a packed lunch and drinks for your child or money for them to purchase refreshments from Gulliver's World. Students entitled to free school meals will be provided with a lunch and drink upon request (please indicate at point of consent, if required).

Please note that we reserve the right to withdraw a student's place on the trip if their behaviour in school causes concern or does not meet the expected standards during the Spring and Summer terms. This is to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all students and staff.
