Uniform Expectations

Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our ongoing commitment to maintaining high standards and raising expectations for all students, I am writing to remind you of our uniform expectations ahead of our return from the summer half-term break.

From Monday 1st June, all students will be expected to:

- Wear their school blazer at all times whilst inside the school building;
- Ensure that shirts are tucked in appropriately;
- Wear their tie fastened correctly to the top of the shirt;
- Refrain from tying coats or jackets around their waist;
- Ensure that skirts are worn at an appropriate length, sitting below students' fingertips when their arms are by their sides.

Students will also continue to be expected to:

- Wear full school uniform, including either formal school shoes or plain all-black trainers;
- Arrive at school each day equipped with their 5 A Day equipment.

These expectations form part of our school uniform policy and help to promote a positive, respectful, and purposeful learning environment.

Students who do not adhere to the expectations outlined above will receive an expectation detention, along with a 20-minute after-school detention on the same day.

We appreciate your continued support in ensuring that students arrive at school dressed appropriately and ready to learn.
