

Headlines - Message from the Head

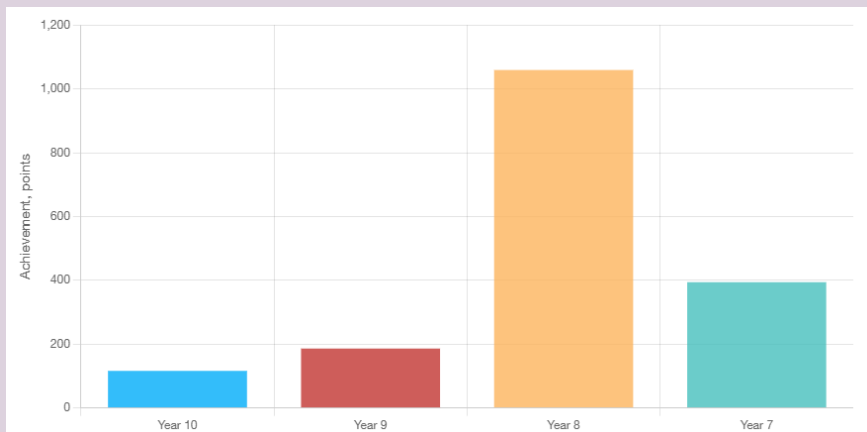

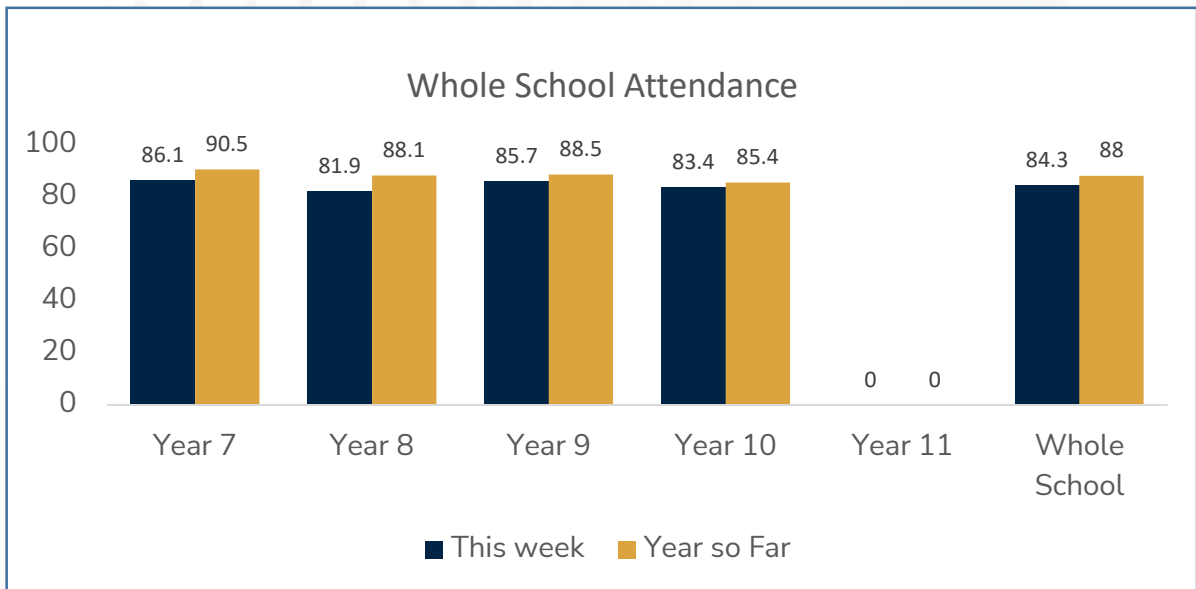

Commercial divers work underwater to carry out tasks such as inspecting and repairing pipelines, ships, oil rigs, or underwater cables. They may also help with building work underwater, search and recovery missions, or scientific research.

Training at a recognized diving school and gaining a qualification approved by the Health and Safety Executive, otherwise known as the HSSE, are required to become a commercial diver in the UK. You also need to pass a full diving medical. There are different levels of qualification depending on the type of diving you want to do, such as inland, offshore, or saturation diving. Good fitness, confidence in the water, and being calm under pressure are all essential skills. Many people also have skills in engineering, welding or construction to help them to find work in this field.

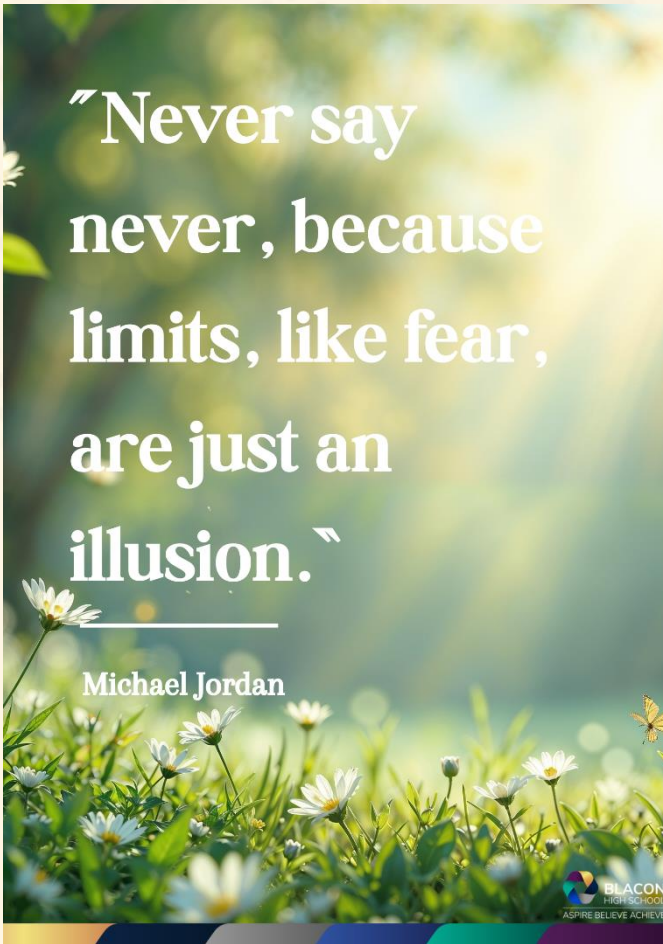
Intrahealth, our local Immunisations team, have been in touch to arrange HPV vaccinations for our Year 8 students on **Tuesday 16th June.**


