Dear Parents, Carers and Year 11 students,

Following my letter earlier regarding adjustments to the Year 11 Record of Achievement Evening, I would like to thank all parents, carers and students who have been in touch today. I completely understand everyone's wishes and the strong desire to be part of this very special occasion. I am particularly mindful that this cohort missed out on many of their Year 6 celebrations due to the Covid pandemic, and I understand how important it is that they have the opportunity to enjoy this milestone event together with families. Please be assured that my overriding priority, as I am sure you will understand, is to ensure that everyone remains safe.

Since writing to you, I have sought further advice from the Health and Safety team at Cheshire West and Chester, alongside specialist engineers, to help us assess and manage temperatures within the venue as effectively as possible. We have considered postponing the event; however, we are aware that many students have already made arrangements to go on holiday following the prom, and we are keen to ensure that no student misses out on this important occasion.

Following this further advice, I am pleased to confirm that parents and carers will be able to attend the event. There will be an overflow area in the diner should the hall be too full.


We have been able to source additional air conditioning units this afternoon, which will help to reduce temperatures in the hall. In addition:

- Bottles of water will be provided to everyone on arrival
- We will aim to minimise movement throughout the evening to support comfort
- Qualified First Aiders will be present throughout the event as an additional precaution
- Senior staff will be present to monitor closely and respond to any concerns

The event will take place indoors, and while every effort is being made to make conditions as comfortable as possible, we ask that parents carefully consider individual circumstances. If you have a medical condition that makes you particularly susceptible to heat, please take this into account when deciding whether they attend. We very much want this to be a positive, memorable experience for all students and appreciate your understanding as we balance this with our responsibility to keep everyone safe.

Thank you again for your continued support and we look forward to seeing you all in what we know will be a special event for everyone.
